Confirmation Defined

From that first Pentecost until now, it has always been the belief of the Church that the Holy Spirit directs and guides us collectively and individually. We have the Spirit of God living and working in our lives and in our Church.

We have each been given gifts according to the plan God has for us. Confirmation prep is a chance for teens to discover their God given gifts and learn how to use them to serve others out in the real world.

Preparations:

2 Teen Sessions approximately 2 hours each

They will bring their Confirmation journal to use and fill out during the preparation. If they do a service or attend a Faith Builder before our first session, the pages are available on the Confirmation webpage for them to print and fill out at the time of completion.

(they can tape/glue or recopy them into their journals later)

We provide two dates for each session, your teen needs to attend only 1 of these dates.

- 1 Retreat approximately 4 hours in August
- **2 Faith Builders** usually 1 hour each (see journal for explanation)
- **3 Service Experiences** (see journal for explanation)

Service Experiences should be in the areas of:

- 1. Church
- 2. Community
- 3. Using their gifts
